EVENTS AND MUSIC HANDLING:

How you register in Entryeeze depends on what music you'll be uploading upon registration.

**** Combined Event** - upload your FD, RD, and/or one pattern dance music.

- Levels Juvenile – Novice: FD and one PD music.
- Levels Junior & Senior – FD and RD

**** Competing Pattern Dance Only**, Register in the equivalent Combined Event and upload one PD music

Preliminary-Pre-Bronze = Juvenile Combined

Bronze-Pre-Silver = Intermediate Combined

Silver = Novice Combined

Pre-Gold = Junior Combined

Gold/International = Senior Combined

If you don't plan to upload any music, you can just skip the upload.

Standard pattern dance music will be available at the Camp.

WHAT TO EXPECT:

On Ice Classes: such as Edge Class, Movement Class, Features Class, and Pattern Dance Featured Step/Key Points Class

Off-Ice Classes: such as Ballroom Dance, Mental Toughness, Performance/Presentation, GOE's and Components, Rules Update, Nutrition/Sports Science, Shadow Dance, Pattern Dance Only dances will be covered in Combined Classes

One-on-One: Each skater will also have a one-on-one on-ice session with a Judge and Technical Controller/Specialist during which the skater can show the officials their Pattern/Rhythm/Free Dance or parts thereof, with or without music and receive feedback.

Camp will run Saturday and Sunday approximately 7:00-6:00 PM, and Monday 7:00-2:00 PM

WHAT TO BRING:

Pack your skates, layers of warm clothes (one rink is chilly), comfortable shoes for off-ice class (ballroom, among other awesome activities), water bottle and snacks. A delicious lunch will be provided Saturday and Sunday. No costumes - this is a working seminar!!

Parents are welcome to observe from the stands while their skater is on the ice.

No Free Auditing.

No Unregistered Skaters in the Stands.

Parents may NOT video during the camp other than their own dancer during the one-on-one
